

TEACHERS' STRIKE DAY

Teachers have been forced to put up with a real-terms pay cut of over 25% since 2008. We need your support:

- **Teachers, like all workers, are struggling with a cost-of-living crisis. Teachers' pay went up by only 2.2% last year. This year's pay should have gone up in April – but teachers have received nothing so far despite inflation being over 11.1%.**
- **Striking is our last resort after 9 months of fruitless negotiations. Strike days will be rotated to minimise the impact on pupils, but there would be no strikes at all if the Scottish Government/COSLA finally stepped up with a fair pay rise.**
- **The Scottish Government must invest properly in Education across the board, including to recruit and retain well-qualified graduates as teachers.**
