(a) intentionally promote homosexuality or publish material with the intention of promoting homosexuality;  
(b) promote the teaching of homosexuality;

28.—(1) The following section shall be inserted after section 2 of the Local Government Act 1986 (prohibition of political publicity)—

“Prohibition on promoting homosexuality by teaching or by publishing material.

2A.—(1) A local authority shall not—

- (a) intentionally promote homosexuality or publish material with the intention of promoting homosexuality;
- (b) promote the teaching in any maintained school of the acceptability of homosexuality as a pretended family relationship.

in England and Wales, a county school, voluntary school, nursery school or special school, within the meaning of the Education Act 1944; and  
(b) in Scotland, a public school, nursery school or special school, within the meaning of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980.”

(2) This section shall come into force at the end of the period of two
