Over a three-year period, most lecturing staff are being offered "less than other public sector pay settlements over a two-year period (2022/23 and 2023/24) such as the NHS (11.8%), Police Officers (12%), Firefighters (12%) and **Teachers (12%)."**

This current pay offer represents an 11.5% pay increase over three years for most lecturing staff in the sector but will be a real-terms pay cut since inflation (RPI) for the period August 2022 – February 2024 is already sitting at 10.4%, and there is still a considerable period to go.
